

PAIN – SERMON 200301

Jesus foretold His own mockery by the Romans (Matt 20:19), and it came to pass (27:29). Jesus also was mocked in the Jewish trial (Luke 22:63), and it was repeated with Herod's men (23:11) and by the soldiers at the cross (23:36).

Matthew 27:35

And they **crucified** him, and parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture *(a covering garment (such as a robe or vestment) b : clothing, apparel.)* did they cast lots.

Jesus is crucified – we except the forgiveness of sin and atonement, but I want to talk to you about the one thing that He took away from you. That he bore on the cross for you. **That's your pain**

So, I want to talk to you today about the **PAIN**

The PAIN of

1. MOCKERY

Matthew 20:19 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁹And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to **mock**, and to **scourge** *(Definition of scourge.1 : whip especially : one used to inflict pain or punishment.)* , and to crucify him: and the third day he shall rise again.

Matthew 27:29 King James Version (KJV)

²⁹And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and **mocked him**, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!

Luke 22:63 Easy-to-Read Version (ERV)

The Guards Treat Jesus Badly

⁶³The men guarding Jesus **made fun of him and beat him**.

Luke 23:11 (ERV)

¹¹**Then Herod and his soldiers laughed at him. They made fun of him by dressing him in clothes like kings wear.** Then Herod sent him back to Pilate. ¹²In

the past Pilate and Herod had always been enemies. But on that day they became friends.

2. BEING BROKEN

Psalm 31:12-13 King James Version (KJV)

¹² **I am forgotten as a dead man out of mind: I am like a broken vessel.**

¹³ For I have heard the **slander** of many: **fear** was on every side: while they took counsel together against me, they devised to **take away my life.**

(What is a broken vessel?)

3. THE BRUISED REED

Isaiah 42:3 King James Version (KJV)

³ **A bruised reed shall he not break,** and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.

Matthew 27:29-31 King James Version (KJV)

²⁹ And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, **and a reed in his right hand:** and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!

³⁰ And they spit upon him, **and took the reed, and smote him on the head.**

4. STRIPPING AWAY YOUR AUTHORITY

³¹ And after that they had mocked him, they took the **robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him**

5. FAILURE

John 17:12

While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, **and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition;** that the scripture might be fulfilled.
